### STORY ORIGIN

Following a performance of MY FATHER'S COAT in London in late January 2020, I was approached by a South African from the audience, enquiring whether I was aware of the story of lan Player and Magqubu Ntombela. I responded that I knew who lan Player was.

The short pause that followed provided a less-than-subtle hint that there was a story waiting to be told. I was intrigued. However my little business was just taking off. And facing a busy schedule, the best I could do was to make a note to explore his suggestion when my schedule allowed.

That moment would arrive sooner than expected. Even from my London hotel room that week, came news of a curious new virus wreaking havoc in Wuhan, China. A pandemic, which was about to provide a potent remedy to my busy schedule. And with my speaking pipeline wiped-out within a month, I was blessed with something which had eluded me for years: time.

In May of that year I was approached by an existing client to tell a story in the bush in northern KwaZulu Natal. It was short notice, but they were looking for a story which was suited to a team who had been working under immense pressure through COVID, but which was suited to the bush.

With the phone pressed to my face, I thought back to my conversation back in London. I requested 24 hours to make a proposal.

The product was a 25-minute short story on Magqubu Ntombela and lan player told around the fire, with my slides projected onto a game-vehicle draped in sheets. It was a fantastic break from lockdown, but more than that, I had come to learn of a story which had some beautiful human ingredients. An untold story which deserved much wider appreciation.

Over the months and years which have followed, my eyes would be opened to a wealth of human insights, as I gradually pieced together two interwoven lives of great consequence.


The story was launched online, given COVID, but has subsequently been told across South Africa, London and the United States.

Few South Africans recognise the full gravitas of Ian and Magqubu's contribution to conservation, globally. I have developed a deep connection to these to men. I have learnt so much from them and consider it a privilege to play a small role in reviving their teachings and considerable legacy. Here is an untold South African success story layered with lessons for the present.

#### CORE THEMES

- 1. Human Connection: The story explores how two men, from very different cultural backgrounds (and who spoke different languages) managed to break down those barriers through a shared sense of humanity. The product was a relationship, both personal and professional, which underpinned the success of these two men.
- 2. Power of Small Teams Bound by Purpose: In saving the white rhino, a small team was assembled around a clear purpose. To quote Margaret Mead: "Never doubt that a small group of thoughtful, committed citizens can change the world; indeed, it's the only thing that ever has."
- 3. Moments of Inspiration: The story involves several moments of inspiration, which have a dramatic impact on the lives of lan and Magqubu. I invoke Plutarch's assertion that the human mind isn't some vessel waiting to be filled, but rather, it is kindling waiting to be sparked.
- 4. Value of Nurturing Networks: Much of Ian and Magqubu's success hinged on their ability to build and then leverage a network. One which opened doors and ultimately enabled their success.

## TARGET AUDIENCES
